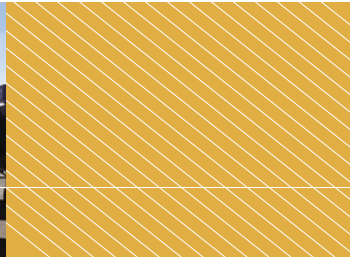
Beyond inventory visibility, you can even track where your employees are within your facility—and the tasks they are performing—in real-time.

Advantages Of RFID And ActiveWave



The basic concept behind RFID is quite simple: Attach a small radio antenna to a microchip and implant it in anything that needs to be read, scanned, monitored, warehoused or alerted. When the RFID tag is activated by a reader device, it transmits information from the chip to a central computer system.

Unlike barcodes, which need to be scanned manually and read individually (you have to actually see a barcode in order to read it), RFID tags do not require line-of-sight for reading. Within the field of a wireless reading device, it is possible to automatically read numerous tags a second.

Taking these benefits even further, ActiveWave provides many technical advantages over other RFID solutions:

Extended read range - A single RFID reader can read up to 279 feet and covers up to 245,000 square feet of floor space.

Long life and highly durable - Our exclusive design brings you the advantages of RFID technology, combined with long life and low cost.

Multi-tag capability - Our tags employ anti-collision logic to assure each tag's information is read, even when multiple tags are attempting to transmit concurrently.

Compact readers - Our RFID readers are designed with the latest technology with optional wireless links to the host computer.

Simplified installation - Our intuitive software and hardware design simplifies the installation and interconnection of ActiveWave system components.

User friendly - Host software uses familiar Microsoft® Windows® ME, 2000 and XP.

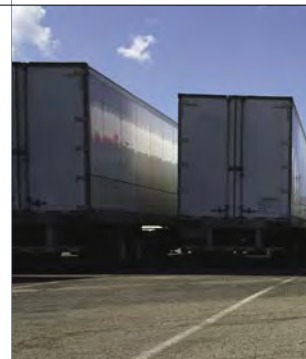
